To consider draft Standing Orders for the new Authority
At the meeting of the Dorset and Wiltshire Joint Committee on 4 June 2015 I reported that one of the key governance documents for early adoption by the new Authority will be its Standing Orders. The Joint Committee was invited to comment on a table comparing the Standing Orders of the two existing Fire Authorities (Appendix 1) and to make recommendations as to which should be retained. Appendix 2 to this report is a set of draft Standing Orders reflecting the recommendations made in the table at Appendix 1.  The Joint Committee supported the proposed Standing Orders and (although not a Committee of the Shadow Authority) to recommend the Standing Orders to the Shadow Authority for adoption at this
Specific consideration was given to quorum. The Combination Order prescribes a quorum of ten, drawn from any of the five constituent Councils. Members supported this and did not wish the quorum to be increased or for there to be a requirement that a particular number of members from each constituent Council should be present in order for a meeting to be quorate.
