


PRE 5 Number of Deliberate primary fires per 10,000 population









PRE 7 Number of Primary fires per 100,000 population Community Safety Forum








PRE 10 Number of children (0-15 years) who are killed or seriously injured in road traffic collisions


Percentage of malicious false alarms not attended by DFRS



Ensuring that our response delivers a swift and professional service in an emergency

Response Priority 1

To protect our community and reduce the risks to firefighters by ensuring known risks are quickly and accurately made available to them prior to their arrival, to provide a safe and effective response

Indicators have been developed, it is intended that these will be reported against from April 2013

Sleeping risks may be private or commercial premises and can be defined as any premises where members of the community may reasonably be expected to be sleeping at any time, and include:

- Dwellings (all house types, flats and houses in multiple occupation)
- Hotels (including guest houses and bed and breakfast establishments)
- Hospitals
- · Residential care homes, nursing homes and sheltered housing
- Caravans and tents (at designated campsites and caravan parks)
- Prisons










RES 2 Percentage of properties with sleeping risk where the second appliance met the response standard






RES 6 Percentage of incidents with a response standard where the number of firefighters 'riding' the appliance met the standard






