There are over fifty fires started by candles every day. Follow our advice to ensure your home is safe.

Make sure candles are secured in a candle holder and away from anything that could catch fire, like curtains or ornaments.





Don't burn lots of candles close together, as this may cause a larger flame, and do not move them once lit.

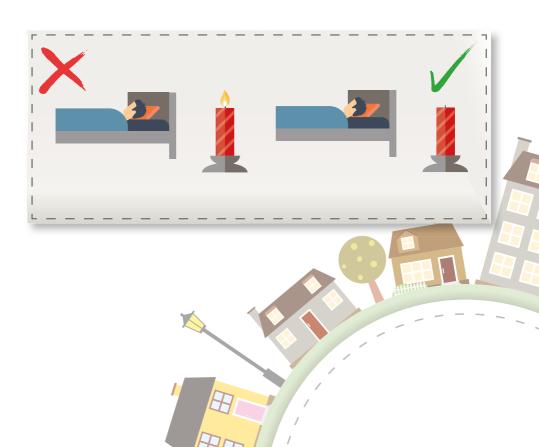




Put out candles, incense or oil burners when you leave the room. Never leave children or pets alone with burning candles and make sure all candles are out before going to bed.
