High rise buildings and “stay put” fire strategy

Query and response:

Please can you tell me how many high rise buildings there are in the area where the fire service or another organisation has decided to change the 'stay put' fire strategy policy at any point over the last three years since June 2017.

The responsible person for one premises has informed us that their evacuation strategy has changed.

For each relevant building please could you state what the new fire strategy policy is, when the policy was changed and why it was changed.

The amended evacuation strategy is now a total evacuation of the building. This was changed post 14 June 2017 as a control measure, in lieu of Aluminium Composite Material type cladding being present on a limited area of the external face of the building.

If possible, please give the name of the building, how many floors it has and the type of cladding it has.
