Appeals - Terms of Reference

Appeals Committee

Terms of Reference

Where the policies of the Fire and Rescue Authority (the Authority) provide for an appeal to elected members the role of the Appeals Committee is to hear and determine an appeal against dismissal brought by any member of staff (conditioned to the Grey Book or the Green book), whether the termination is for a disciplinary matter, ill health, redundancy or some other substantial reason.

Note: Issues related to the employment of the Chief Fire Officer/Deputy Chief Fire Officer

Any member of Senior Leadership Team subject to Gold Book terms and conditions shall be referred in the first instance to the Appointments and Disputes Committee for decision. Where Gold Book conditioned officers are entitled to appeal a decision of the Appointments and Disputes Committee then any such appeal shall be to the Appeals Committee.

Membership: Any five members appointed on a politically proportionate basis.

The Appeals Committee has no standing membership, instead members will be appointed from amongst the whole membership

of the Authority as the need to meet arises

Chairman: To be appointed on each occasion from amongst the membership

of the Committee

Meetings: No standing meetings

Reporting arrangements: To the Authority

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
