

# Freedom of Information Request FOI 20 06

### Number of incidents from 2009 to 2019

## Query and response:

I would like a breakdown of figures regarding on-call fire fighters and fire incidents across the past decade in Wiltshire and Dorset.

For calendar years 2009 to 2019:

Dorset Fire and Rescue Service and Wiltshire Fire and Rescue Service combined to form Dorset & Wiltshire Fire and Rescue Service on 1 April 2016 so this response covers both Dorset and Wiltshire.

1. How many times were Wiltshire and Dorset Fire and Rescue Service called to a fire incident?

<sup>\*\*\*</sup> This information is only available from Summer 2015 onwards and is only recorded for incidents where we were in sole attendance. For example, if Hampshire Fire and Rescue Service were also in attendance then this would not be included in these figures.



5. How many fires were missed (e.g. because of no staff / equipment, fire and rescue service did not need to attend)?

This information is not held. Our mobilising system will only propose available pumps to attend and incident, therefore if a pump isn't available then it isn't proposed for the incident.

6. How many on-call firefighters were in Wiltshire and Dorset Fire and Rescue Service in total?
