A. 6 months.

Q. At what age must you apply to renew your driving licence if you want to continue driving?

A. 70 years of age

Q. How soon before you turn 70 can you apply for your new driving licence?

A. Up to 90 days before

Q. Up to what distance should you be able to read a vehicle registration plate?

A. 20 metres (or the length of 5 cars)

Q. Where else can you find more information on returning to the road as an older driver?
