

Freedom of Information Request FOI 23 50

Active transport

Query and Response:

This is a data request both under the Freedom of Information Act and the Environmental Information Regulations.

In consideration of the climate crisis, I would like to request the following information about how the organisation is enabling staff to reduce their emissions through sustainable transport, and more specifically, cycling.

1) over the past five years, broken down by year – Our current scheme started on 1st September 2020; our previous scheme ended in 2016.

- a) how many staff members used the Cycle to Work scheme? From 1st September 106 staff members have opted to join the scheme. We currently employ 1354 staff Service wide
- b) what percentage of staff was this? 7.8% have participated
- c) what was the average value of the vouchers claimed on the scheme? £1897.77
- d) what was the number of those who took up the scheme, who then failed to complete, leaving the organisation with costs? **None**
- 2) what tools does the organisation use to encourage cycling for their staff -
- a) on a work basis The cycle to work scheme is well publicised but due to the nature of our business and distance between work locations, it isn't practical for staff to cycle between locations.
- b) on a leisure/health basis The cycles to work scheme is well publicised and Uniformed staff are obligated to maintain a certain level of fitness.
