STATUS OF REPORT	For open publication
PURPOSE OF REPORT	For consideration and note
EXECUTIVE SUMMARY	In September 2022 the Authority provided financial approval to improve the operational training facilities. During this meeting it was agreed that the project would be strategically overseen by the Finance & Audit Committee. Appendix A to this report provides Members with their first strategic highlight report, noting the progress of the project along with the budget position, an overview of the risks and mitigation and the expected next steps.
	Currently the project is going through the planning and procurement phase, which is expected to last until Spring 2024, when the construction phase then commences. Due to this protracted period of technical approvals, a strategic highlight report will be provided in December 23 and July 24 and thereafter on a quarterly basis for the lifetime of the project.
	Given the wider economic volatility and to ensure an accurate budgetary provision over the final designs, a comprehensive financial report will be brought to the committee in December 23.
RISK ASSESSMENT	The provision of operational training is a statutory duty under Section 7(2)(b) of the Fire and Rescue Services Act 2004. It is fundamental to ensuring the safety and wellbeing of our staff and communities. The current facilities need significant enhancements to meet the

	operational and welfare needs of our firefighters and their instructors. As a core statutory duty, the Authority must ensure it has sufficient and suitable training facilities for its firefighters.
COMMUNITY IMPACT	An impact analysis has been undertaken to support the development of the two training centres. A community engagement programme is in place for the project and is regularly reviewed.
BUDGET IMPLICATIONS	An update on the budgetary position is provided in Appendix A to the report. Which highlights a forecasted increase from the original budget provision. This is largely due to the economic climate and some design changes to meet planning requirements.
	A comprehensive financial report will be brought to the committee in December 23.
RECOMMENDATIONS	It is recommended that Members:
