

Apprenticeship Public Statement 1st April 2023 - 31st March 2024

We are required by the Government to publish our progress in achieving the measures set out in the Enterprise Act. While the public sector apprenticeship target of 2.3% of the workforce being an apprentice has been removed, we will maintain these report figures for the past financial year.

Details of Dorset & Wiltshire Fire and Rescue Service progress on the apprentice target to 31 March 2024 are shown in the tables below.
