Hose reels currently operated by Dorset & Wiltshire Fire and Rescue Service

Query and response:

Please could you provide details of the hose reels fitted to the pumping appliances currently operated by Dorset & Wiltshire Fire and Rescue Service, including:

1. Internal diameter of hose reel tubing (e.g. 19 mm, 22 mm)*, length (e.g. 60m, 80m) and whether different hose reel sizes are used across the fleet. (*And if currently using 22mm, please you also provide the year when these were first brought into use in your service, if this is available).

Dorset & Wiltshire Fire and Rescue Service (DWFRS) currently use 19mm hose reels and have 3 x 60m length on each side of the vehicle.

2. Nominal hose reel flow rate and pump operating pressure.
Hose reel flow rate is selectable between 50 and 200 lpm and pump pressure is up to 40bar but generally is operated at an average 25bar
3. Make and model of pumps fitted to current frontline pumping appliances.
All frontline appliances are fitted with a Godiva 2010 multi pressure pump.
4. Make and model of hose reel branch(es).
We currently supply the Viper Attack 1560.
